Item APIs provide the same functions that can be performed in Process Orchestration for Empowered Teams UI. The following APIs are available for Items:

- Add Item: Owners and Partners of Process Orchestration for Empowered Teams can use the Add Item API to create a new item.
- **Edit Item**: Owners and Partners of Process Orchestration for Empowered Teams can use the <u>Edit Item API</u> to edit or modify an existing item.
- **Search Item**: Owners and Partners of Process Orchestration for Empowered Teams can use the <u>Search Item API</u> to search for an existing item.
- **Delete Item**: Owners and Partners of Process Orchestration for Empowered Teams can use the <u>Delete Item API</u> to delete an existing item.
